

**2016-17 LEVI'S STADIUM EVENT DAY
RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMIT PILOT PROGRAM GUIDELINES**

1. Residential Parking Permit Guidelines:

- a. Permits are intended for use only on event days at Levi's Stadium. The permit *does not* exempt a vehicle from any other City of Mountain View parking restriction(s) or ordinance(s).
- b. Permits are valid in the following neighborhoods (map is attached):
 - Old Mountain View Neighborhood: Evelyn Avenue to the north, Calderon Avenue to the east, Mercy Street through California Street to the south, and Franklin Street to the west.
 - Willowgate Street Neighborhood: Central Avenue (between Stierlin Road and Horizon Avenue) to the north, Orchard Avenue to the east, Willowgate Street to the south, and Stierlin Road to the west.
 - The businesses along Moffett Boulevard between Central Expressway and Central Avenue.
- c. Permit holders must reside in the neighborhoods listed above. A permit holder is defined as a household owner(s), person(s) renting a residential unit in the program area, or business owner(s).
- d. Permits are valid from August 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017, only on event days at Levi's Stadium (see Section 4 for a list of events).
- e. Cars displaying a permit may park on public streets in the neighborhoods listed above without time parking restrictions from 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on weekday events and 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on weekend event days at Levi's Stadium (see Section 4 for a list of events).
- f. One (1) permit per vehicle (including trailers, boats, motorcycles).
- g. Permit holders must hang the permit from a vehicle's rear view mirror so that it is clearly visible and identifies permit holders.
- h. A permit does not guarantee a permit holder the availability of parking spaces on a public street, or within a specific neighborhood.
- i. Selling, fraudulently using, reproducing, or misusing a parking permit shall result in the forfeiture of the permit.

2. Additional Permits: Two permits were provided to each household within the above-listed neighborhoods via mail. If a household owner or person(s) renting a residential unit or business owner within the above-mentioned neighborhoods requests additional permits for additional vehicles, they must come to City Hall (500 Castro Street), Finance and Administrative Services Department (Second Floor), with proof of residency or business. City Hall is open Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Acceptable proof of residency or business shall be a current valid vehicle registration with the current address. If the address is not current, please bring a driver's license or a utility bill for additional verification. The number of additional permits issued per household or business will be at the discretion of the City. The permit pilot program cannot accommodate requests for one-day guest passes.

3. Stadium Event Day Parking Restriction: The on-street parking in neighborhoods within the pilot program area will be restricted to three-hour times from 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on weekday events and 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on weekend event days at Levi's Stadium. Please note parking on Castro Street will have a one-hour time limit. Daily or regular parking restrictions would not apply on those event days. Vehicles parked in the above-mentioned neighborhoods without a permit shall comply with the stadium event day parking restrictions or they will be cited by the City of Mountain View Police Department.
4. Levi's Stadium Event Days: The program will go into effect only on 49er game days in the 2016-17 season. If additional event days are added to the pilot program, those days will be posted on the City's website (www.mountainview.gov) and related street signage. The City will do its best to inform permit holders of additional dates, but encourage holders to check the street signs.
