*Due to the ongoing drought, the Mountain View City Council has declared a Stage 1 water shortage emergency condition.*

## Water Conservation Tips

- Please reduce landscape water use. Turn off irrigation systems when it rains and during the winter.
- Save water by checking for leaks. Visit [mountainview.gov/leakcheck](http://mountainview.gov/leakcheck) to view the online leak check guide.

## Do Not:

- ✗ Allow water to run off into paved areas (gutters, sidewalks, streets).
- ✗ Allow broken equipment to waste water.
- ✗ Wash paved surfaces and vehicles with a hose that does not have a shutoff nozzle.

## Do:

- ✓ Fix leaks within 10 days.
- ✓ Install a shutoff nozzle on your hose when washing paved surfaces and vehicles.
- ✓ Restaurants: Ask before serving water.
