Definition: To suppress fires, provide advanced life saving and rescue services, and perform fire prevention and other duties in the fire service.

Distinguishing Characteristics: Firefighters/Paramedics work under the immediate supervision of the Fire Captain. In addition to the typical tasks required for the appropriate fire suppression classifications, Firefighters/Paramedics perform Advanced Life Support (ALS), prehospital emergency medical care, and emergency medical assistance to victims of accidents, injuries, or illnesses.

Examples of Duties: Duties may include, but are not limited to, the following:

- 1. Respond with Company to all alarms and/or emergency calls. Participate in the control and extinguishment of fires.
- 2. Perform rescues, ventilation, extinguishment, overhaul, and salvage activities as assigned.
- 3. Rescue persons endangered by fires or other hazards.
- 4. Perform advanced emergency medical services as a Paramedic.
- 5. Conduct fire prevention inspections. Eliminate fire hazards through the enforcement of fire code and fire safety education.
- 6. Maintain skills and knowledge through participation in training and skill maintenance programs.
- 7. Maintain firefighting and EMS equipment, fire station and related grounds, facilities, and supplies in a clean, orderly, and usable condition as assigned.
- 8. Maintain a level of physical fitness required to perform assigned tasks.
- 9. Communicate and coordinate emergency medical treatment with other County paramedic personnel.
- 10. Prepare patient care reports and submit reports concerning medical activities.

11. Train other Fire Department personnel in the use of specialized medical equipment or techniques.

- 12. Present first-aid training and related programs to the general public.
- 13. Often required to make decisions affecting life and property without direct supervision.
- 14. Perform other related duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications:

<u>Knowledge of</u>: Advanced Life Support prehospital emergency care techniques, principles, and practices; basic human anatomy and physiology; medical terminology, techniques, and analytical processes used in the description and assessment of patient status; drug categories, applications, contraindications, and appropriate dosage level; procedures and equipment use used in vital sign monitoring; symptoms of impaired cardiac and respiratory functioning; altered state of consciousness; various types of poisoning, shock, and common diseases; applicable laws, codes, and ordinances.

<u>Ability to</u>: Evaluate condition of a patient(s), take and monitor vital signs, communicate with the Base Hospital, and select and implement a course of medical action based on medical protocols and orders.

Experience and Training Guidelines: A combination of relevant experience, education, and training that will satisfy the required minimum qualifications, knowledge, and abilities.

Education equivalent to a high school diploma or GED. Normal hearing and vision, or correctable to a normal level, and good physical condition.

Required Licenses or Certificates: Valid California Driver License with the ability to obtain a valid driver's license approved by the California Department of Motor Vehicles to operate firefighting vehicles prior to completion of probation. Must possess and maintain a valid California Paramedic License and be able to obtain accreditation to operate as a Firefighter/Paramedic in Santa Clara County within six months of appointment.
