The City is required to inspect NOI sites at least monthly during for the nine-month period from September through May.

A. Stormwater NOI Construction Site Inspections (MVCC Chapter 35, Division 3). The NOI construction site inspection fee is based on the anticipated number of monthly inspections that will be performed throughout the duration of the project.
