Apply now for an opportunity to receive
\$500 monthly basic income

You may be eligible if:

- You are a Mountain View resident;
- Your income is extremely low; and
- You have a child under the age of 18.

Program basics:

- 166 participants will be selected randomly from eligible applications.
- Participants will receive \$500 per month for two years.
- The goal is to help families overcome financial challenges, including impacts from the COVID-19 pandemic.
