NOTIFICATION TO THE RENTAL HOUSING COMMITTEE OF VACATED UNIT DUE TO A JUST CAUSE TERMINATION

This form can be used by Landlords to notify the Rental Housing Committee (RHC) that a Tenant vacated a rental unit as a result of a termination notice or a subsequent action for unlawful detainer. The Notification to the Rental Housing Committee must be submitted within seven (7) days after the Tenant has vacated the unit.

Please file the notification online, if possible, by logging on to mvrent.mountainview.gov. If you have not yet created an account please use the Accessor's Parcel Number (APN) and Personal Identification Number (PIN) provided on your Rental Housing Fee Invoice to create an account. If you no longer have access to this information, please contact andrea.kennedy@mountainview.gov to retrieve your APN and PIN.
