ARES is comprised of FCC Licensed Amateur Radio Operators (Hams) who are trained and practiced in providing emergency communications during a disaster, including communications between Neighborhood CERTs and the City Emergency Operations Center (EOC). Despite not being an officially recognized City of Mountain View CERT Neighborhood Group, approximately 2/3 of ARES Hams are CERT trained, and most live within the boundaries outlined above. Hams hold radio check-in practice every Monday night beginning at 7:30 p.m. and operating on various frequencies until about 8:30 p.m.

*Mountain View ARES is not an officially recognized City of Mountain View CERT Neighborhood Group, rather a local team of volunteer radio operators dedicated to providing emergency communications support to local, county, and state governments during disasters and other emergencies.
