SUBJECT: Addendum No. 1 to RFQ No. R251084 for the City of Mountain View for Public

Works Department Land Development Civil Engineering Support Services

This Addendum becomes a part of Request for Qualifications (RFQ) No. R251084 and must be signed, acknowledging receipt, and returned with the completed qualifications statement.

The City's Response to firms' questions and clarification request:

1. The RFQ lists four areas of Civil Engineering Support Services. If a firm only provides one or two of the services listed, will that firm be deemed nonresponsive because they don't provide all services areas?

<u>City Response</u>: Firms may submit a Statement of Qualifications for any or all of the services identified on the RFQ list. A firm would not be deemed nonresponsive for providing one or two of the services listed.

2. If a firm only provides one of the four services listed, can the firm submit for just that one service area?

City Response: Yes, a firm may submit for just one of the service areas.

3. Is the RFQ looking for a separate proposal for each of the four service areas listed? If a firm is submitting for all four areas, would that result in four separate proposals (each with a page count as identified in the RFQ)?

<u>City Response</u>: The Statement of Qualifications for each service area can be combined in one proposal.

4. Do the front and back covers count toward the 20-page limit?

<u>City Response</u>: No, the statement of qualification shall have a maximum of twenty (20) pages excluding cover and back covers.

5. Should a firm provide a single hourly rate for the entire contract, or submit rates for each contract year?

<u>City Response</u>: Once the City establishes the on-call services list through the RFQ process and there is a need for services, firms will be requested to submit an updated hourly rate fee schedule and fee proposal when submitting the Request for Proposals (RFP).

6. Section O.c. states the firm needs to have a minimum of 5 years of longevity. Does a firm in business less than 5 years qualify for the proposal?

<u>City Response</u>: As part of the criteria for qualifications, firms are required to have a minimum of 5 years of longevity.

7. Can you provide the unlocked version of the forms to fill out?

<u>City Response</u>: Attachment A and B are unlocked and fillable PDFs. Attachment C is a sample contract between selected Firms and the City of Mountain View, and it is for reference only.
